Supportive Housing

The RRVCA Supportive Housing Project... is a complex with three three-bedroom apartments designed to house families who were previously homeless. Residents are able to live independently, with rental assistance. Case management and supportive services are provided to assist residents in moving toward self-sufficiency in a safe atmosphere.



Eligibility Requirements

- 1) Applicants must currently be homeless; either sleeping in places not meant for human habitation, in transitional or emergency shelters, or being evicted within the week and not having any subsequent residence identified.

- 2) One adult member of the family must be diagnosed with a disability. Disabilities may include:

- Diagnosable substance abuse disorder
- Serious mental illness
- Developmental disability
- Positive HIV or AIDS status
- Physical illness or disability

- 3) Be at or below 125% of the federal poverty guidelines.

- 1) Complete a SHP application with your case manager and submit required documents to RRVCA.
